## STUDY JAPANESE!

The **major** in Japanese Language and Culture requires 30 semester hours numbered above JPN 2220 including a minimum of six semester hours at the 4000-level. A maximum of 9 semester hours in Japanese culture and literature can count toward the 30 semester hour requirement.

The **minor** requires 12 semester hours in Japanese courses numbered above JPN 1121. Credit extended in meeting the foreign language requirement for graduation may not be used in satisfying the minor. The **minor** allows students to choose any combination of courses in language and culture.

Note: A maximum of three semester hours from the following coursework may count toward the **major** or **minor**: JPW 2501, JPN 1112, JPN 3302, JPN 3132, JPN 3133.
